

ADRODDIAD BLYNYDDOL LLAWN I RIENI / GWARCHEIDWAID 2019-2020

Annwyl Riant / Warcheidwad,

Rwy'n falch iawn fel Cadeirydd y Corff Llywodraethol i gyflwyno adroddiad blynyddol ar gyfer Ysgol Gynradd Llechryd am 2019 – 2020.

Hoffwn achub ar y cyfle i ddiolch i'r Pennaeth, yr holl athrawon, cynorthwyr dysgu, staff ategol, y rhieni / gwarcheidwaid, cyd-aelodau ac wrth gwrs y disgyblion am eu gwaith caled dros y flwyddyn, ac am eich cydweithrediad a chymorth dros cyfnod anodd ac heriol eleni.

Rwy'n siŵr fy mod yn siarad ar ran y Corff Llywodraethol i gyd wrth fynegi fy malchder yn y cyfleoedd ardderchog sy'n cael eu cynnig i'r holl ddisgyblion, a'r ymdrech i dynnu sylw at dalent a diddordeb arbennig pob plentyn. Diolch eto i'r tîm staff am eu hymdrechion ac ymroddiad sicrhau'r cyfleoedd hynny.

Bydd yn ofynnol o hyd i Lywodraethwyr Ysgol gynhyrchu adroddiad blynyddol. Ni fydd y gofynion i adrodd ar berfformiad, absenoldeb a thargedau ysgolion yn yr adroddiad blynyddol yn berthnasol eleni. Rydym hefyd yn atal Rheoliadau Targedau Perfformiad ac Absenoldeb Ysgolion (Cymru) 2011. Mae hyn yn golygu na fydd yn ofynnol i ysgolion adrodd ar dargedau mewn perthynas â pherfformiad neu absenoldeb ar gyfer blwyddyn academaidd 2019/20, neu eu gosod ar gyfer blwyddyn academaidd 2020/21 (ac ni fydd yn ofynnol i awdurdodau lleol awdurdodi targedau). Ni fydd angen cyhoeddi targedau eraill, megis y rhai a osodwyd dros dro mewn blynyddoedd blaenorol, mewn unrhyw gynlluniau neu adroddiadau newydd ysgol (e.e. Cynlluniau Datblygu Ysgol neu Adroddiadau Llywodraethwyr).

Mae'n ofynnol o hyd i ysgolion gynhyrchu prosiectws ysgol ac i awdurdodau lleol gynhyrchu prosiectws cyfansawdd. Er ei bod yn bwysig bod rhieni a rhanddeiliaid eraill yn parhau i gael gwybodaeth, bydd y rheoliadau'n cael eu haddasu i sail 'ymdrechion rhesymol' i ddarparu hyblygrwydd o ran cynnwys. Bydd hyn yn cynnwys dileu'r gofynion statudol cyfredol i adrodd ar berfformiad ysgolion (a gyhoeddir ar DEWi) ac ar absenoldebau.

Penderfynwyd Llywodraeth Cymru i gau ysgolion o ganlyniad i effaith y Coronavirus ar ddydd Gwener 20fed Mawrth. Darparwyd gwaith ar gyfer eich plentyn i barhau â dysgu dros y cyfnod ansicr ac nid oedd gorfodaeth i wneud y gwaith. Er hynny, roedd yn hollbwysig i'ch plentyn i ddarllen yn gyson ac i ymarfer mathemateg.

Cyfathrebwyd yn gyson â rhieni drwy ebost/ffon wrth i fwy o wybodaeth ein cyrraedd.

Cynlluniwyd y cam cyntaf i ailagor ar 29 Mehefin wrth i'r ysgol gweithredu fesul cam. Rhannwyd blynyddoedd ysgol mewn i grwpiau, gan gyrraedd yr ysgol a chael egwyl ar adegau gwahanol. Traean, ar y mwyaf, o'r disgyblion a oedd yn bresennol ar unrhyw adeg.

Roedd y dosbarthiadau yn llawer llai, gan roi amser penodol, diogel i'r disgyblion gyda'u hathrawon a chyd-ddisgyblion. Roedd yr amser hwn yn cynnwys profiad dosbarth ar-lein a phersonol, gan baratol plant a staff ar gyfer profiad tebyg ym mis Medi.

FULL ANNUAL REPORT TO PARENTS / Guardians 2019-2020

Dear Parent / Guardian,

I am delighted as Chair of the Governing Body to present an annual report for Ysgol Gynradd Llechryd for 2019 – 2020.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Headteacher, all teachers, teaching assistants, support staff, parents / guardians, co members and of course the pupils for their hard work over the year, and for your co-operation and support over a difficult and challenging time this year.

I'm sure I speak on behalf of the whole of the Governing Body in expressing my pride at the excellent opportunities offered to all pupils, and the effort to highlight the special talent and interest of every child. Thanks again to the staff for their efforts and commitment to securing those opportunities.

School Governors will still be required to produce an annual report. The requirements to report on performance, absence and school targets in the annual report will not apply this year.

We also suspend the School Performance and Absence Targets (Wales) Regulations 2011. This means that schools will not be required to report or set performance or absence targets for the 2019/20 academic year / 21 (and local authorities will not be required to authorize targets). Other targets, such as those set temporarily in previous years, will not need to be published in any new school plans or reports (eg School Development Plans or Governor Reports).

Schools are still required to produce a school prospectus and local authorities to produce a composite prospectus. Although it is important that parents and other stakeholders continue to receive information, the regulations will be adapted to 'reasonable efforts' to provide flexibility of content. This will include removing the current statutory requirements for reporting on school performance (published on DEWi) and on absences.

The Welsh Government decided to close all schools due to the impact of the Coronavirus on Friday 20th March. Pupils were provided with work to continue learning over the uncertain period and there was no compulsion to do the work. However, it was vital for your child to read regularly and to practice mathematics.

The school has been in regular communication with parents via email / phone as more information arrives.

The first phase was planned to reopen on June 29 as the school took a phased approach. School years were divided into groups, arriving at school and having breaks at different times. A maximum of a third of the pupils were allowed to be present at any one time.

Classes were much smaller, giving pupils a dedicated, safe time with their teachers and classmates. This time consisted of an online and personal classroom experience, preparing children and staff for a similar experience in September.

Ers y penderfyniad i gau ysgolion ym mis Mawrth ar gyfer darpariaeth statudol, mae dealltwriaeth o'r feirws a'i effeithiau hirdymor wedi parhau i ddatblygu ac roedd y tair wythnos ym mis Mehefin a Gorffennaf yn gyfle i ddisgyblion 'Ddod i'r Ysgol, Dal Ati i Ddysgu a Pharatoi' ar gyfer Mis Medi.

Drwy wneud hyn, roedd yn rhoi amser cyswllt hanfodol i blant cyn gwyliau'r haf, ac yn arwain at fanteision pwysig yn gymdeithasol ac o ran dysgu a'r bwch cyrhaeddiad. Roedd hyn yn helpu i baratoi dysgwyr ar gyfer yr amser cyswllt fydd ar gael iddynt ar ôl gwyliau'r haf, ac yn caniatáu i'r ysgol brofi eu dulliau gweithredu cyn yr hydref. Roedd yn gyfle pwysig i brofi'r mesurau diogelwch sydd yn ei lle a chael hyder ynddynt. Diogelwch staff a disgyblion oedd ac yn dal i fod yn flaenaf. Nid oedd rhaid i riant neu'n warcheidwad anfon eich plentyn/plant yn ôl i'r ysgol ddiwedd mis Mehefin. Roedd y plant yma hefyd yn parhau i gael Cymorth trwy Teams / ebyst.

Roedd 'dal i fyny' yn golygu rhoi cyfle i bob disgybl weld eu hathrawon wyneb yn wyneb, er mwyn asesu eu lles a gweld pa gymorth sydd ei angen arnynt. Nid oedd disgwyl i athrawon gynnal rhaglen lawn dan yr amgylchiadau presennol ac o fewn yr amserlen hon.

Penderfynodd y Sir i beidio adael addysg derbyn i ailgychwyn cyn diwedd tymor yr haf ond cadarnhaodd y Gweinidog Addysg ar 9 Gorffennaf y bydd pob disgybl yn medru dychwelyd i'r ysgol fis Medi.

Bydd tymor yr Hydref yn cychwyn ar 1 Medi 2020 gyda dau ddiwrnod o gynllunio. Bydd yr holl ddisgyblion nôl erbyn 9fed o Fedi. Fel Cadeirydd y Corff Llywodraethu rydw i'n deall y bydd dychwelyd i drefn yn parhau i fod yn heriol, ac mae'n bosibl y bydd y cyfnod clo wedi cael effaith sylweddol ar y disgyblion ac ar eu cysylltiad ag addysg yn yr ysgol. Dilynodd yr ysgol canllawiau manwl gyda gwybodaeth ynghylch rheoli y cyfleusterau a threfniadau ymarferol, gan gynnwys adeiladau, adnoddau, glanhau a thrafnidiaeth.

Diolch eto i'r tîm staff am eu hymdrechion ac ymroddiad sicrhau'r cyfleoedd hynny.

Since the decision to close schools in March for statutory provision, understanding of the virus and its long-term effects has continued to develop and the three weeks of June and July were an opportunity for pupils to 'Come to School, Catch Up and Prepare for September'.

In doing so, it gave children vital contact time before the summer holidays, and brought important social and learning benefits and the achievement gap. This helped prepare learners for the contact time that will be available to them after the summer holidays, and allowed the school to test their approaches before the autumn. It was an important opportunity to test and gain confidence in the security measures in place. The safety of staff and pupils was and continues to be paramount. A parent or guardian didn't have to send your child (ren) back to school at the end of June. These children also continued to receive support through Teams / emails.

'Catching up' meant giving all pupils the opportunity to see their teachers face to face, to assess their wellbeing and see what help they need. Teachers were not expected to run a full programme under the current circumstances and within this timescale.

Reception education were not to resume before the end of the summer term but the Education Minister confirmed on 9 July that all pupils will be able to return to school in September.

The Autumn term starts on September 1st 2020 with two days of planning. All pupils will be back by September 9th. As Chair of the Governing Body I understand that returning to a routine will continue to be challenging, and the lock-out period may have had a significant impact on the pupils and their involvement in school education. The school followed detailed guidelines with information on managing the facilities and practical arrangements, including buildings, resources, cleaning and transport.

Thanks again to the staff team for their efforts and commitment to securing those opportunities.

Newidiadau i gyfarfodydd Blynyddol y Rhieni / Llywodraethwyr

Mae Adran 94 y Ddeddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013 (y Ddeddf) yn gwneud newidiadau pwysig i'r trefniadau deddfwriaethol blaenorol oedd yn ymwneud â Chyfarfodydd Blynyddol y Rhieni/Llywodraethwyr. Mae'n darparu trefniadau newydd lle gall rhieni ofyn am gyfarfod gyda chorff llywodraethol.

Fodd bynnag, bydd angen i'r rhieni fodloni pedwar (4) gofyniad statudol wrth alw cyfarfod sef:-

- (i) rhaid i rieni 10% o'r disgyblion cofrestredig, neu rieni 30 o'r disgyblion cofrestredig (pa un bynnag sydd isaf) arwyddo deiseb yn gofyn am gyfarfod;*
- (ii) rhaid mai diben y cyfarfod yw trafod materion sy'n ymwneud â'r ysgol;*
- (iii) y nifer fwyaf o gyfarfodydd y gall rhieni ofyn amdanynt o fewn unrhyw flwyddyn ysgol yw tri (3);*
- (iv) rhaid bod yna ddigon o ddiwrnodau ysgol ar ôl yn y flwyddyn ysgol i ganiatáu cyfarfod.*

At hynny:-

- (a) rhaid cynnal y cyfarfodydd cyn diwedd cyfnod o 25 niwrnod;*
- (b) mae'r cyfnod o 25 niwrnod yn cychwyn y diwrnod ar ôl derbyn y ddeiseb, ond nid yw'n cynnwys unrhyw ddiwrnod nad yw'n ddiwrnod ysgol;*
- (c) os oes angen cynnal cyfarfod arall o ganlyniad i ddeiseb wahanol, ni fydd y cyfnod o 25 niwrnod yn dechrau tan y diwrnod ar ôl cynnal y cyfarfod arall;*
- (ch) rhaid bod digon o ddyddiau ar ôl yn y flwyddyn ysgol i gynnal cyfarfod cyn diwedd y cyfnod o 25 niwrnod;*
- (d) bydd cyfarfodydd yn agored i holl rieni'r disgyblion cofrestredig yn yr ysgol, y Pennaeth ac unrhyw un arall a wahoddir gan y corff llywodraethol;*
- (dd) mae'n rhaid i hysbysiad y cyfarfodydd i'r rhieni gynnwys dyddiad, amser a lleoliad y cyfarfod ynghyd â'r mater neu faterion i'w trafod.*

There was no call for a Governors meeting with Parents in accordance with section 94 of the School Standards and Organization (Wales 2013) Act during the 2018-19 educational year.

See details below which highlight the requirements of holding an annual meeting.

Changes to Annual Parents / Governors meetings

Section 94 of the School Standards and Organization (Wales) Act 2013 (the Act) makes important changes to the previous legislative arrangements relating to Annual Parents / Governors Meetings. It provides new arrangements where parents can request a meeting with a governing body.

However, parents will need to meet four (4) statutory requirements when calling a meeting namely: -

- (i) parents of 10% of registered pupils, or parents of 30 registered pupils (whichever is lower) must sign a petition requesting a meeting;
- (ii) the purpose of the meeting must be to discuss matters relating to the school;
- (iii) the maximum number of meetings parents may request within any school year is three (3);
- (iv) there must be enough school days left in the school year to allow a meeting.

In addition: -

- (a) the meetings must be held before the end of a period of 25 days;
- (b) the 25 day period begins the day after receipt of the petition, but does not include any day which is not a school day;
- (c) if a different petition requires a further meeting, the 25 day period shall not begin until the day after the other meeting;
- (d) there must be enough days left in the school year to hold a meeting before the end of the 25-day period;
- (d) meetings shall be open to all parents of registered pupils at the school, the Headteacher and any other person invited by the governing body;
- (f) the notice of meetings to parents must include the date, time and place of the meeting together with the matter or matters to be discussed.

Appointments: In January 2020 Miss Meinir Lewis was appointed as the new Headteacher of Cenarth Primary School in partnership with Llechryd Primary School.

Mr Rhys Hughes, teacher for three days a week and Ms S. Harman teaching assistant were also appointed to start in September 2020 and working 10 hours a week. We wish them the best at our school.

AGM (October 2019) There was no demand for a meeting during October 2018. Action taken as a result of any decisions made at the meeting - No decision taken at the October 2019 meeting.

Financial details - See appendix outlining a full statement of the school budget.

How does the school use the money?

- school budgets are generally a very challenging area in recent years and we are working very closely with the Education Authority to make the best use of available funding. The school budget was used to ensure the best educational experiences for the pupils and to secure suitable resources for them.
- The school uses additional funding to target literacy and numeracy.

Social Deprivation Grant - The Social Deprivation Grant is used purposefully to meet the needs of specific pupils, additional resources and staff have been organized to support and raise standards in these areas.

Donations to the school

- Generous contributions were received from the Parents' Association. The school greatly appreciates the support.

Allowances or subsistence to the governing Board

- Governors travel costs - No expenses were paid to the governors during the year 2019-20. I want to thank my fellow governors for giving their service on a voluntary basis for the benefit and welfare of the school.

Review of School Policies and Strategies - the school regularly reviews policies to ensure the best provision for the pupils. All school policies have been reviewed and specifically those relating to health and safety, child protection, bullying, and some curricular aspects. Policy Review Action - Developments are regularly monitored at termly meetings. Staff from the school receive further training in child protection and implementing autism-friendly school procedures.

Sport and Extra Curricular Activities

The school provides a variety of sporting activities in all aspects of Physical Education. Pupils gain skills and experiences from Reception up to Year 6. The addition of cycling and scooter activities were activities in the Spring term. There is an extensive extra-curricular program that aims to satisfy the interests of all pupils in the school. Each year the school staff prepares pupils for the district and regional eisteddfodau. The Christmas concert is very popular with parents and the community.

Urdd Eisteddfod - The Urdd Club is held weekly where school staff volunteer to offer various activities to the pupils. I would like to thank all the teachers and staff for their work and the parents for all their co-operation and support.

Healthy eating and drinking - the school promotes pupils' health and is keen to develop healthy eating and drinking patterns. Healthy school lunches are provided daily and pupils are encouraged to eat healthy lunchboxes. Fruit is available daily and there is plenty of water available for the pupils, all pupils are encouraged to bring an appropriate plastic bottle.

Teachers continue to review the curriculum in the light of new developments. Great emphasis is placed on developing communication skills, number skills, ICT skills and thinking skills. The school works very closely with Ysgol Cenarth to develop programmes of rich experiences.

Additional Learning Needs: The school makes every effort to ensure that every child feels integral to the life and work of the school and fulfills their individual potential. The school regularly reviews the Additional Learning Needs policy to ensure appropriate support for pupils.

Pupils with disabilities: The school campus has been regularly adapted to provide easy access for pupils with disabilities, ramps are to promote access and careful planning has successfully integrated children with disabilities into the school curriculum.

Use of Welsh in school

- Welsh is used in the Foundation Phase and Key Stage 2 as the main language in all aspects of the school's curricular and extra-curricular work. English is introduced to pupils in Year 3.
- There is no restriction on the use of Welsh in the school, Welsh is promoted in all aspects of the life and work of the school.
- The school ensures through careful planning that there is constant continuity and development in the experiences to use Welsh in all curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- Pupils who are late arrivals to the school can take advantage of the Language Centre provision organized by the Education Authority.
- Pupils transfer to secondary schools where there are opportunities for them to continue to develop their use of Welsh.
